RE: MPSJ issue

The above matter refers.

PCAM has been receiving e-mails and letters from some members that they are having difficulties with their clients in Subang Jaya because the municipal council wants their clients to employ Pest Control companies that are in the council's panel, failing which, the council will refuse to issue business licences to their clients.

PCAM has been trying to contact the Yang DiPertua (YDP) of Subang Jaya to arrange a dialogue with them to try to bring to them our member's grouses of doing business in Subang Jaya, but so far, it has not been fruitful as claimed by our Secretary, because the YDP seems to be very busy with his duties. The last time our Secretary communicated was on 8th August 2007, his secretary replied that he is in some kind of *khursus*, saying that he would be back some time the following week.

As such, the exco of PCAM is calling all PCOs to a forum to discuss what the next course of action should be. During the forum, you will be briefed on the chronology of events that have taken place since this issue came about and what action we have taken to resolve the issue. We would welcome suggestions from the PCOs on what further actions that need to be taken to resolve the issue.

The forum will be held at PCAM office on Wednesday, 29th August 2007 at 2.30 pm. Please confirm your attendance by e-mail or fax to PCAM or contacting PCAM office by 27th August 2007.

Items for Discussion:

- 1) Should we need to register as MPSJ's panel?
- 2) Should we comply with all their rulings as meted in their guidelines?
- 3) Co-operation with all local councils as raised by one member under our M & A?

We hope your participation in the forum will bring a positive outcome to the issue.
